Anthony Ritchie is a renowned composer whose works have been performed by ensembles such as The Takacs Quartet, and soloists such as Bella Hristova. His Symphony No.4 *Stations* was one of the recordings of the year by MusicWeb International, 2015.

In 2016 Anthony was joint winner of The NZ Classical Album of the Year *Fjarran: In the Distance*. His choral work *Gallipoli to the Somme* was performed in London and Oxford, 2018. Anthony's book chapters include 'Gallipoli to the Somme: A Musical Witness to History' in *Studies in History and Sociology of Music* (2020).

Anthony is currently Professor of Music at Otago University, and Head of the School of Performing Arts.
